**BOIL ALERT LIFTED FOR SOUTHWESTERN FRANKLIN  
COUNTY**

The boil alert in place since Tuesday for residents of the below streets on the county's southwest side has been lifted. Tests confirm that water is safe for drinking, cooking, bathing, and other uses.

- All homes on the north side of Sullivant Avenue between Inah and Redmond Avenue.
- All homes on the following streets between Sullivant and Owen Avenue:
  - Inah
  - Postle
  - Fernhill
  - Evergreen Terrace
  - Woodlawn
  - Hiler
  - Redmond

The initial boil alert was due to a water main break on Tuesday, 10/21. The area that was affected can be seen at the following Google Earth URL:
