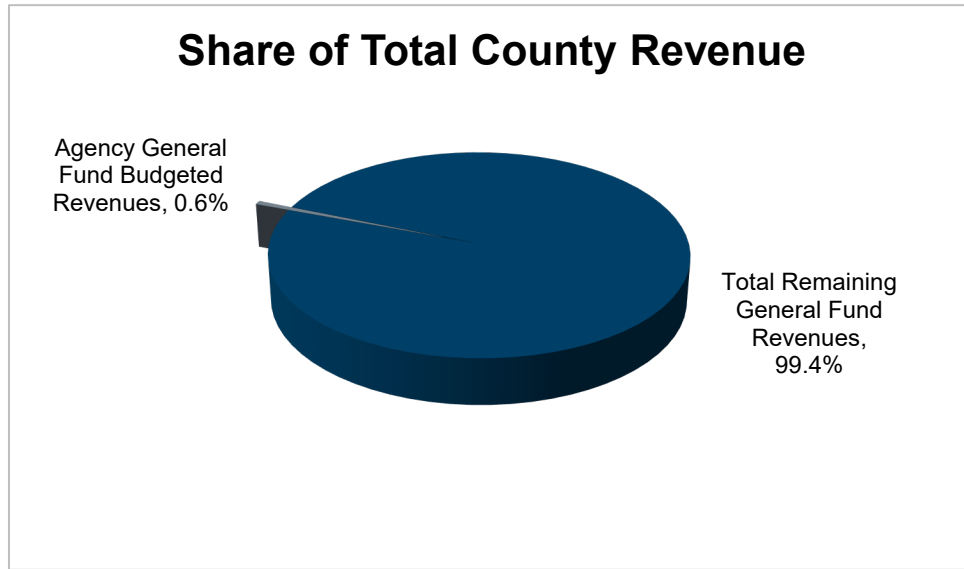
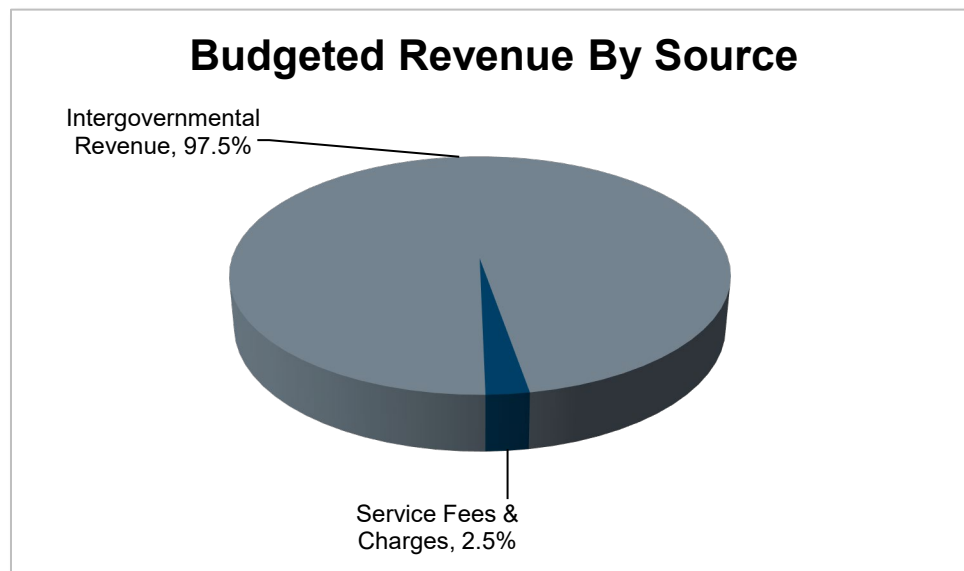


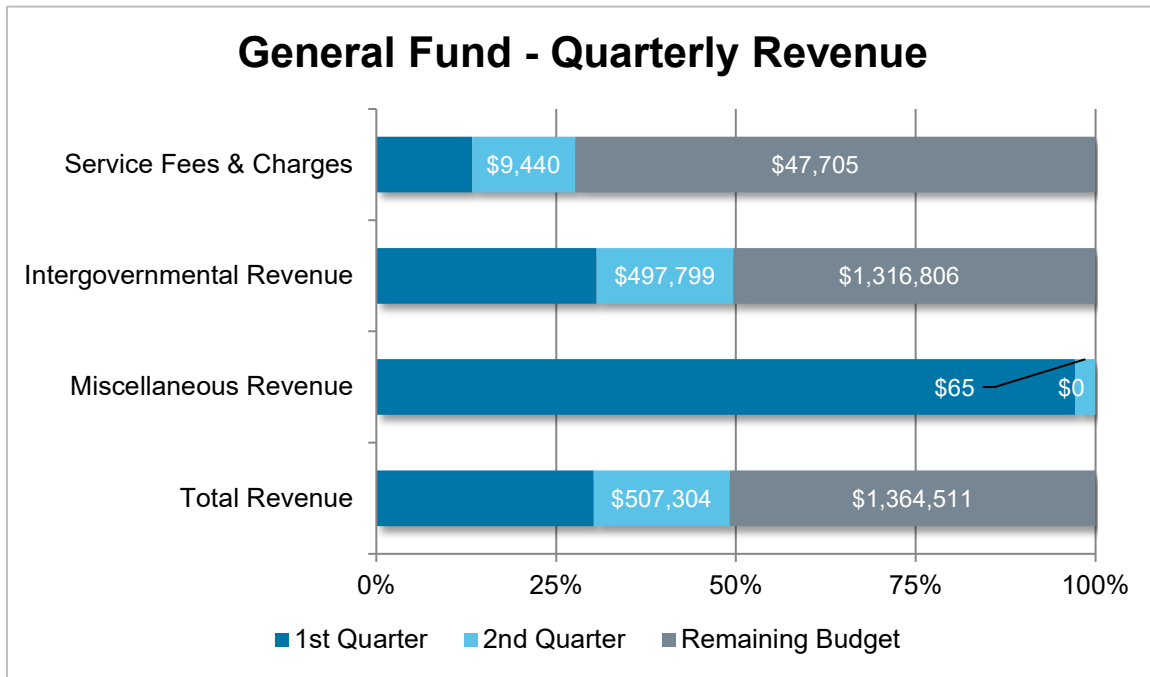
General Fund – Revenue Analysis



- The General Fund revenue for the Common Pleas Court is estimated to be **\$2,680,984** for 2021, which is **0.6%** of the total budgeted revenue for the General Fund.



- The main sources of General Fund revenue for the Common Pleas Court are reimbursements from the State Public Defender’s Office for appointed counsel legal fees associated with indigent defense services and reimbursements from the Targeted Community Alternatives to Prison (TCAP) Fund.

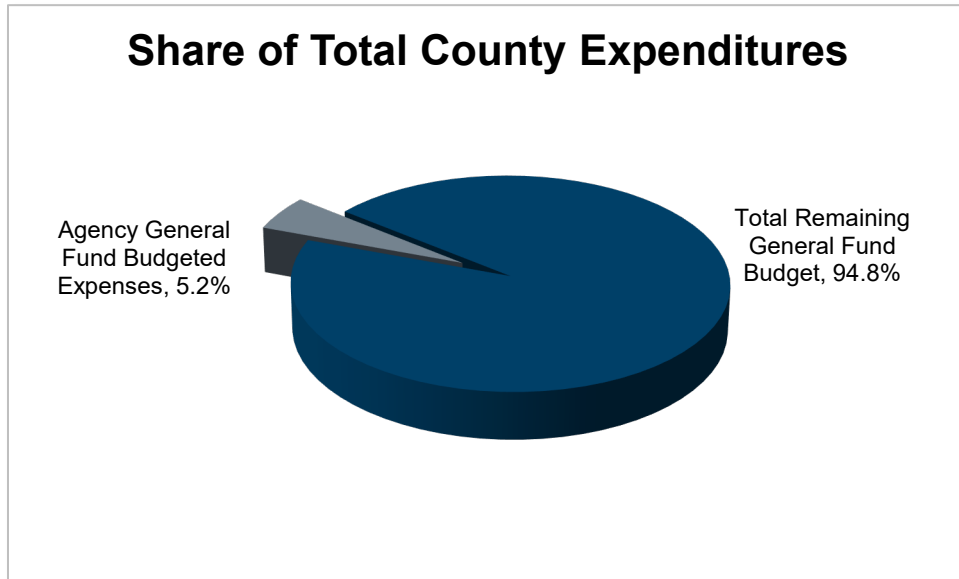

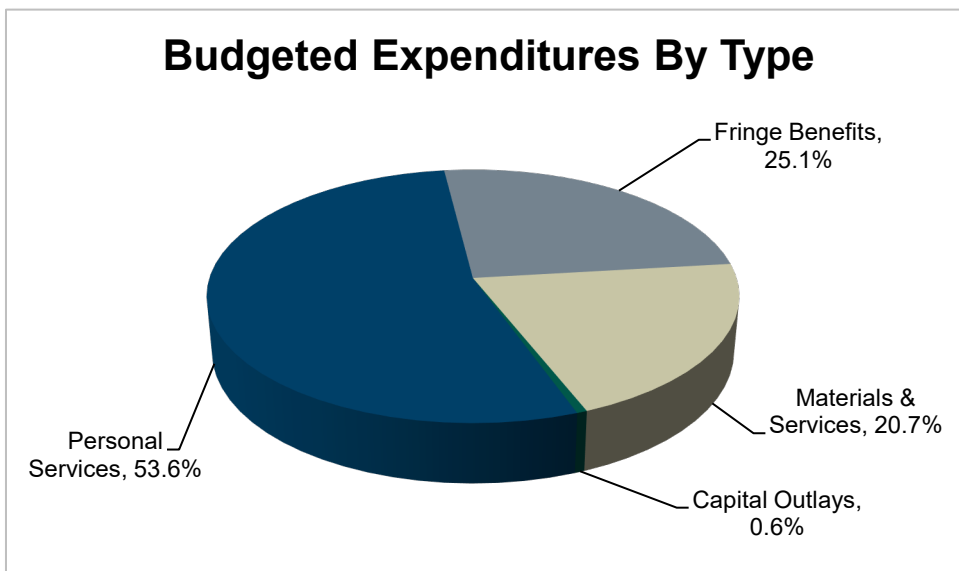

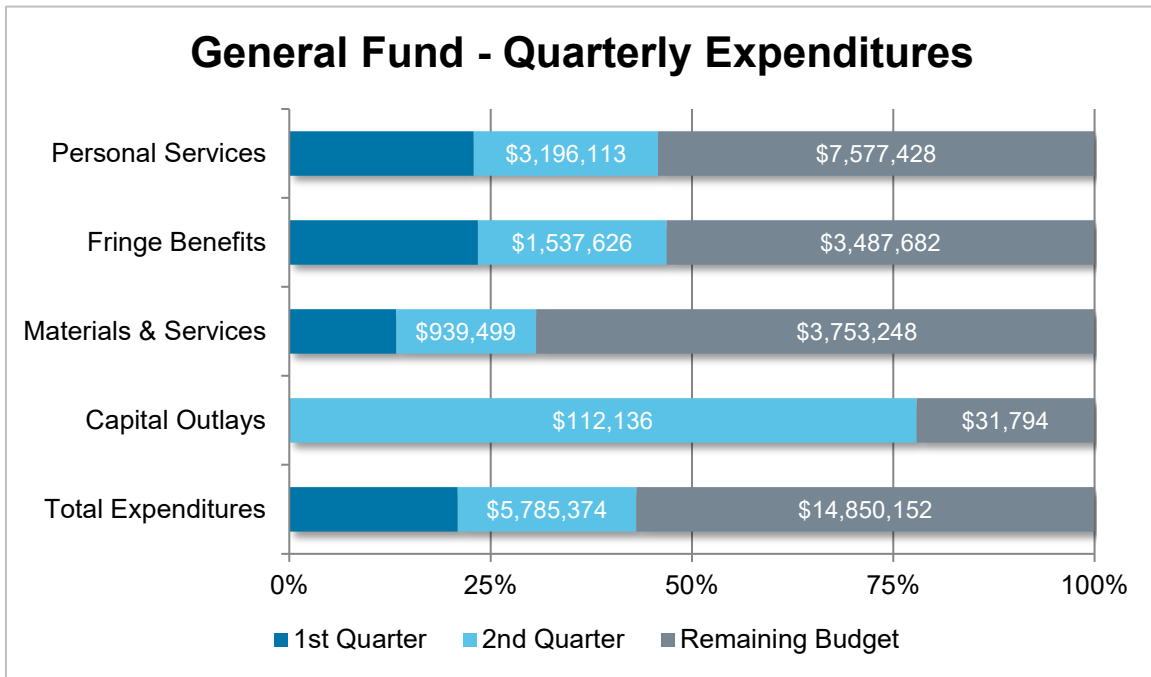
- Second quarter revenue of **\$507,304** represents **18.9%** of the budgeted amount for the year. YTD revenue of **\$1,318,758** represents **49.2%** of the budgeted amount for the year.
- Service Fees & Charges include the funding received from the Ohio Department of Mental Health and Addition Services and the County ADAMH Board in support of the Drug Court. A total of \$9,440 or 14.3% of the budget was received in the 2nd quarter as compared to \$4,823 in the prior year. The variance is due to the timing of these collections.
- Intergovernmental Revenue received in the 2nd quarter was \$497,799 or 19.0% of the budgeted amount. This is a decrease of \$166,478 or 25.1% less than the prior year, which is primarily due to the timing of reimbursement from the State Public Defender’s Office and caseload fluctuations. Year-to-date, \$1,298,243 or 49.6% of the budgeted amount has been collected compared to the \$1,613,500 collected in the prior year.

General Fund – Expenditure Analysis



- The General Fund expenditures for the Common Pleas Court are estimated to be **\$26,095,834** for 2021, which is **5.2%** of the total budgeted expenditures for the General Fund.

- Second quarter expenditures of **\$5,785,374** represent **22.2%** of the budgeted amount for the year. YTD expenditures of **\$11,245,682** represent **43.1%** of the budgeted amount for the year.
- Materials & Services expenditures were \$939,499 or 17.4% of the budgeted amount during the 2nd quarter. A major expenditure within Materials & Services is appointed counsel legal fees, in which \$429,521 or 16.0% was spent during the 2nd quarter. This is \$204,196 or 47.5% more than the \$225,326 spent during the 2nd quarter of 2020.
- Budgeted within Capital Outlays is an allocation for office equipment and video arraignment equipment, of which \$112,136 or 77.9% was spent during the 2nd quarter.

- There were twelve pay periods through the end of the 2nd quarter, which would equate to 46.2% of the budgeted amount. There were no significant variances in Personal Services expenditures during the 1st or 2nd quarters.

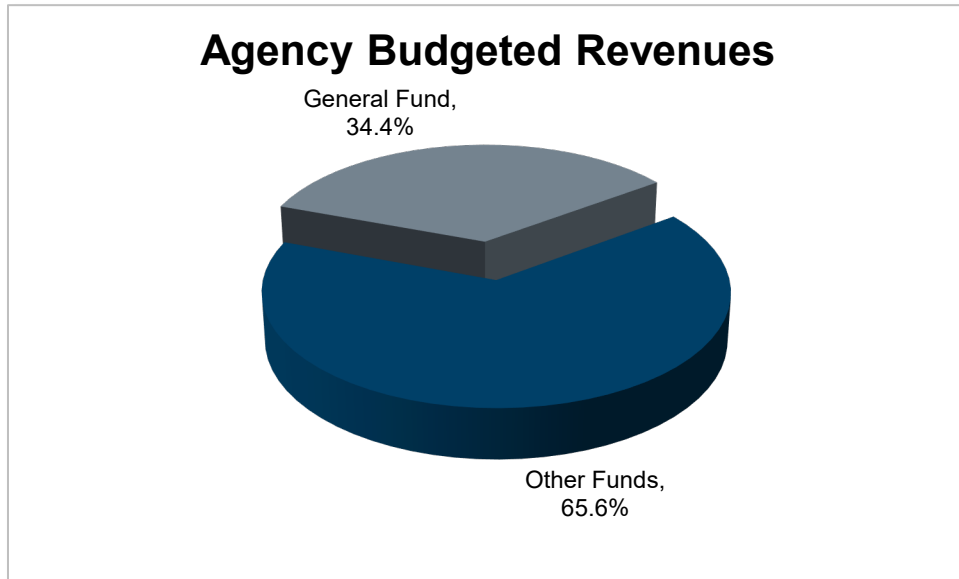

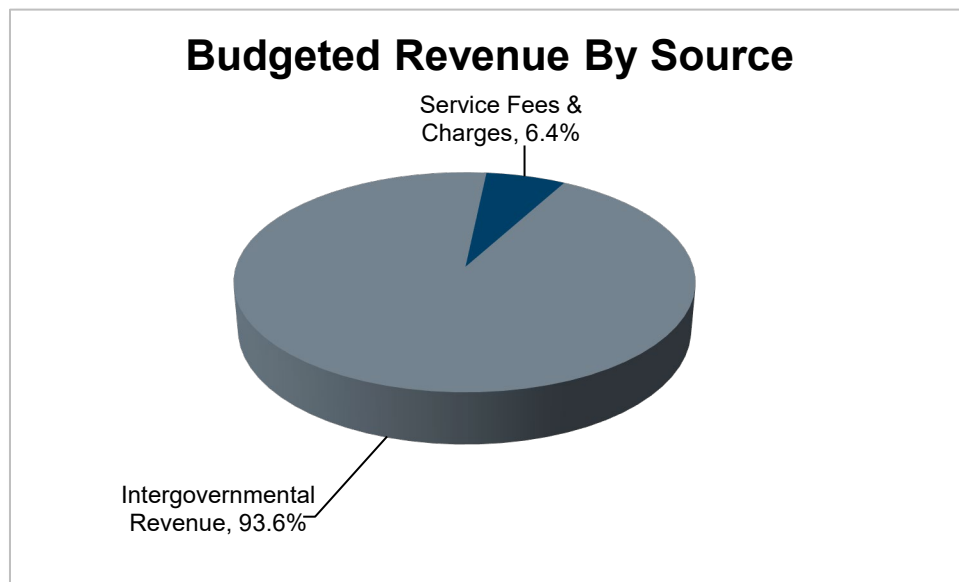
Additional Budget Analysis

- The State Public Defender’s Office notified counties during the 1st quarter of 2021 that the reimbursement rate for county indigent defense expenditures for the remainder of state fiscal year 2021 would be increased from 70% to 80%. The approved version of the state biennial budget for fiscal years 2022-2023 (House Bill 110) provides for 100% reimbursement for county indigent defense expenditures beginning in July 2021.

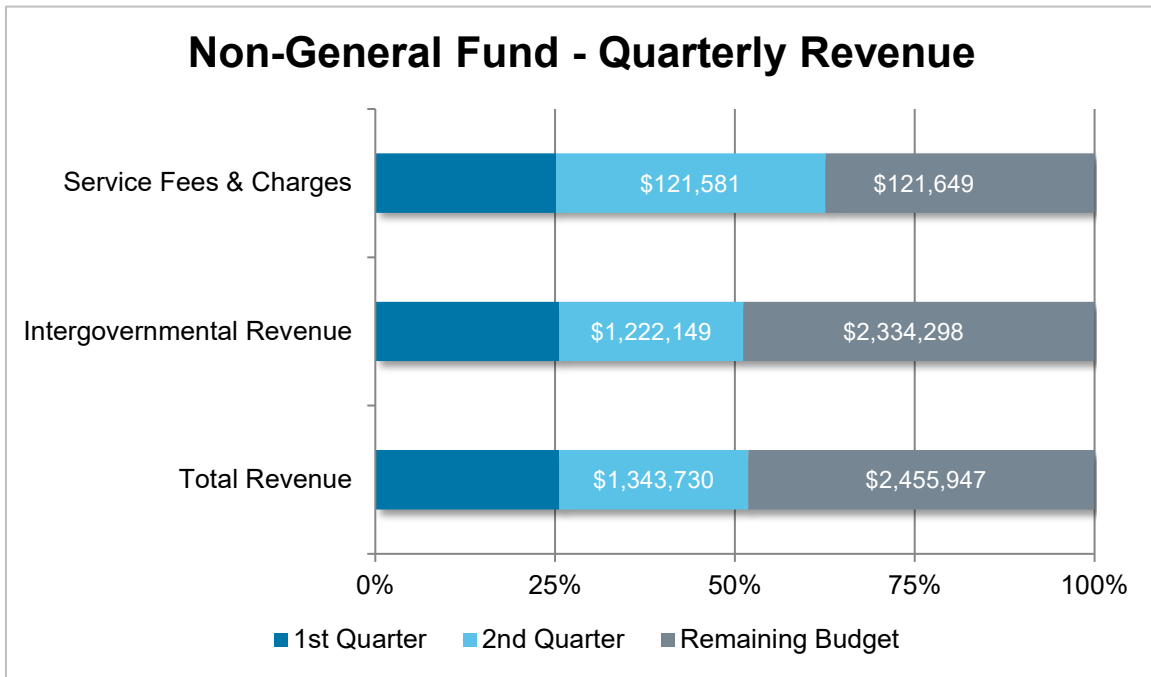
Non-General Fund – Revenue Analysis



- The non-general fund revenue for the Common Pleas Court is estimated to be **\$5,103,512** for 2021, which is **65.6%** of the total budgeted revenue for the Common Pleas Court.



- The main sources of non-general fund revenue for the Common Pleas Court are various grant awards from the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Corrections for the Community Corrections Felony Fund, Community Corrections Misdemeanor Fund, the Justice Reinvestment Fund, and the TCAP Fund.

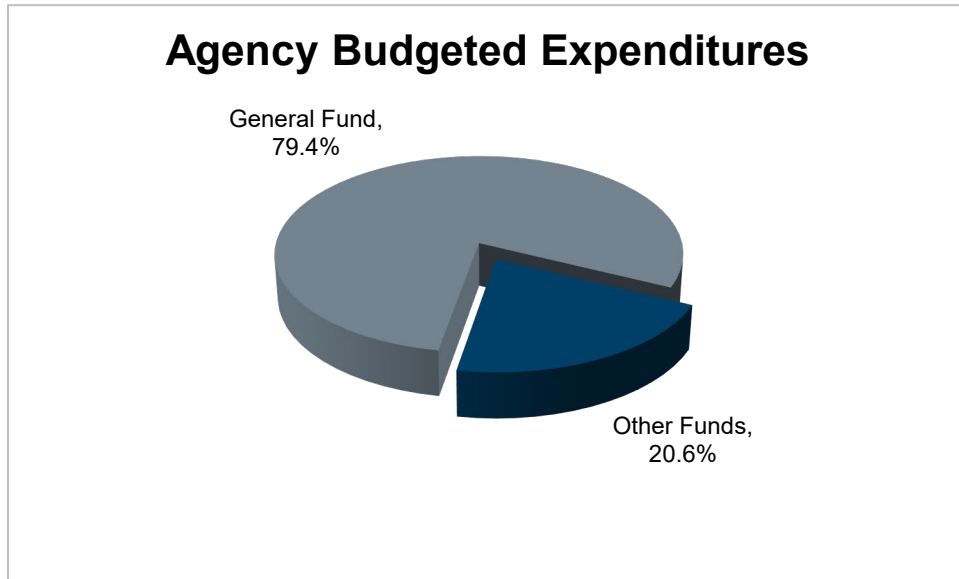

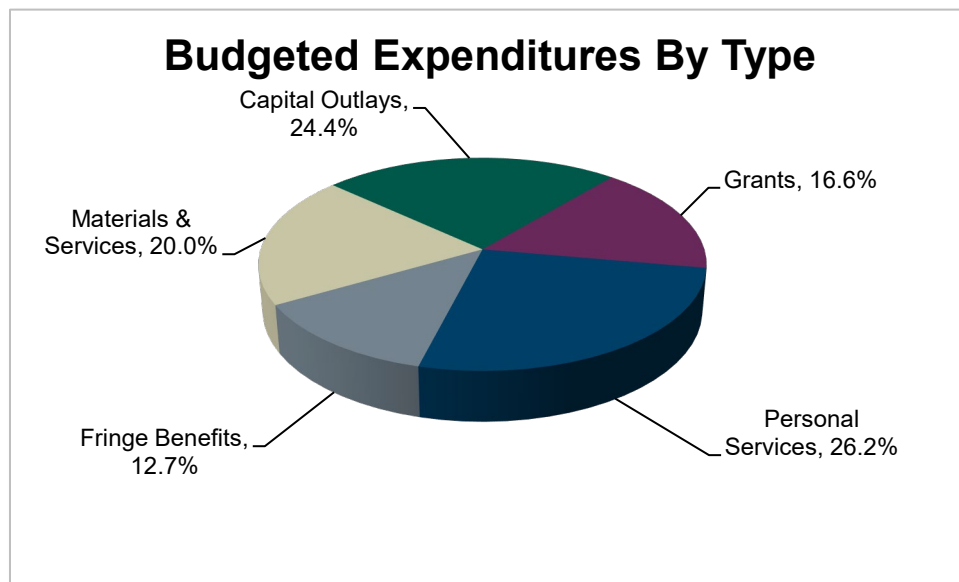

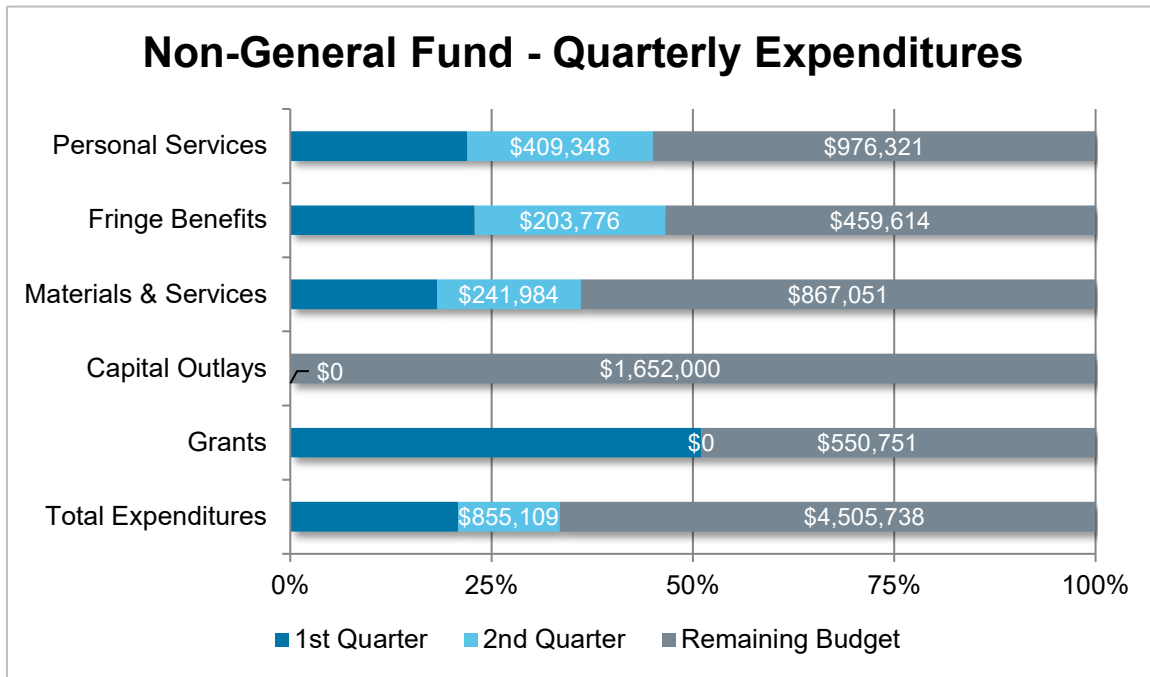
- Second quarter revenue of **\$1,343,730** represents **26.3%** of the budgeted amount for the year. YTD revenue of **\$2,647,565** represents **51.9%** of the budgeted amount for the year.
- Service Fees & Charges include court filing fees (computerization fees), home incarceration fees charged daily to non-indigent participants, and probation fees charged to each probationer. During the 2nd quarter, \$121,581 or 37.4% of the budgeted amount has been collected for the above fees.
- Intergovernmental Revenue includes grant funds from the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Corrections (ODRC) for diversion programs and treatment services. During the 2nd quarter, \$1,222,149 of the budgeted amount has been received, as compared to \$1,159,649 received in the 2nd quarter of 2020. The difference of \$62,500 is due to the timing of collection and is also the reason for the variance between prior and current year revenue.

Non-General Fund – Expenditure Analysis



- The non-general fund expenditures for the Common Pleas Court are estimated to be **\$6,770,641** for 2021, which is **20.6%** of the total budgeted expenditures for the Common Pleas Court.

- Second quarter expenditures of **\$855,109** represent **12.6%** of the budgeted amount for the year. YTD expenditures of **\$2,264,903** represent **33.5%** of the budgeted amount for the year.
- Materials & Services are expended on an as needed basis. Expenditures during the 2nd quarter were \$241,984 or 17.8% of the budgeted amount, as compared to \$263,862 in 2020.
- Within Capital Outlays is an allocation for an upgrade of the AV equipment in the media room and twelve courtrooms in the Common Pleas Capital Fund.
- Grant expenditures are related to the payments from the TCAP Fund to reimburse the General Fund for the costs associated with the Risk Reduction Officers. Year-to-date, \$574,249 has been expended as compared to \$518,831 in 2020. The variance is related to timing of expenditures.
