



COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIPS

Community Partnership grants are awarded via a competitive process to support local community-based organizations that serve County residents. To qualify for funding, the applicant organization must have attained 501(c)(3) non-profit status from the IRS. Additionally, proposals must demonstrate how effectively and efficiently the initiative or program will address the Board of Commissioners core principles and Rise Together Poverty Blueprint action steps and goals.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY?



- Registered as a 501 (c) 3.
- Authorized in the State of Ohio.
- Organization is serving Franklin County residents.

COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP GRANT

- Programming and Operational support.
- Maximum Request \$500,000 annually.
- Funding is for up to a maximum of three years (i.e. one year with two one-year extensions).
- Not open to Current Community Partner or Health Equity Grantees.





Youth- Ensure all young people are on track for long- term success.






