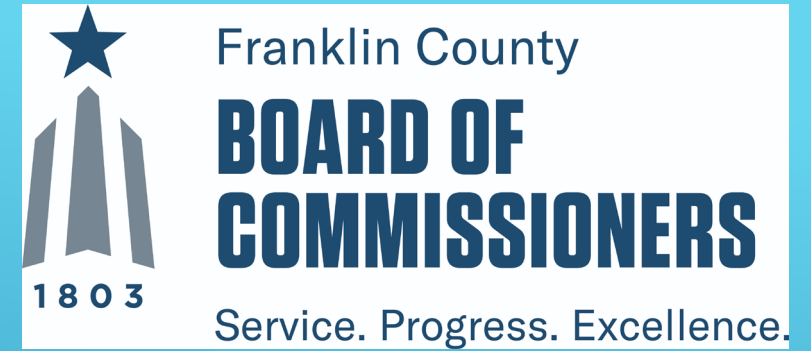

# FRANKLIN COUNTY COMMUNITY FUNDING INITIATIVE

- \$5M investment from the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund.
- Authorized by the American Rescue Plan Act.

# FRANKLIN COUNTY COMMUNITY FUNDING INITIATIVE

Funding may be used for:

- Revenue Losses.
- Increased Costs.
- Increased client expenses.



# FRANKLIN COUNTY COMMUNITY FUNDING INITIATIVE

## Revenue Losses:

- Fundraising events
- Fee for service losses
- Individual donation losses
- Reimbursements
- Social Enterprise/Retail

# FRANKLIN COUNTY COMMUNITY FUNDING INITIATIVE

## Increased Business Expenses:

- Purchase of equipment
- Zoom/Teams licenses
- PPE
- COVID-19 Cleaning Services
- Data Management Infrastructure

# FRANKLIN COUNTY COMMUNITY FUNDING INITIATIVE

## Increased Client Expenses:

- Child Care
- Education and Training
- Medical, Physical and Mental Health
- Stable Housing e.g. rent and utility assistance
- Technology/Internet access
- Transportation
- Food/Nutrition

# FRANKLIN COUNTY COMMUNITY FUNDING INITIATIVE

## Use of Funds

Grant funds **may not** replace or supplant federal funds.

# FRANKLIN COUNTY COMMUNITY FUNDING INITIATIVE

## Who May Apply?

Nonprofit organizations  
operating in Franklin County for  
at least 3 years.

# FRANKLIN COUNTY COMMUNITY FUNDING INITIATIVE

## Who May Apply?

Nonprofit organizations must be in good standing with the federal Internal Revenue Service.

MUST submit a copy of the IRS determination letter and most recent copy of IRS Form 990.

# FRANKLIN COUNTY COMMUNITY FUNDING INITIATIVE

Nonprofit organizations must be compliant with the State of Ohio Attorney General's Office.

# FRANKLIN COUNTY COMMUNITY FUNDING INITIATIVE

## How Much May I Apply For?

The maximum grant award is 50% of revenue losses / increased expenses up to \$50,000 for non-profit agencies primarily serving Franklin County residents **in** a Qualified Census Tract.



# FRANKLIN COUNTY COMMUNITY FUNDING INITIATIVE

## How Much May I Apply For?

The maximum grant award is 25% of revenue losses / increased expenses up to \$25,000 for non-profit agencies primarily serving residents outside of a Qualified Census Tract.

# FRANKLIN COUNTY COMMUNITY FUNDING INITIATIVE

## How Much May I Apply For?

One application per  
organization.

# FRANKLIN COUNTY COMMUNITY FUNDING INITIATIVE

## What is a QCT?

Any census tract (or equivalent geographic area defined by the Census Bureau) in which at least 50% of households have an income less than 60% of the Area Median Gross Income (AMGI).

# FRANKLIN COUNTY COMMUNITY FUNDING INITIATIVE

## What is a QCT?

Defined by US Dept of HUD

# FRANKLIN COUNTY COMMUNITY FUNDING INITIATIVE

## Why focus on QCTs?

Residents living in a QCT have been hardest hit by the COVID-19 pandemic.

# FRANKLIN COUNTY COMMUNITY FUNDING INITIATIVE

- Applications will be reviewed on a rolling basis.
- Funding is being provided on a first come, first served basis.
- Notice will be provided if awarded or why the application was rejected.

# FRANKLIN COUNTY COMMUNITY FUNDING INITIATIVE

- Upon notice of award, the organization must approve the terms and conditions of the award (which are currently under legal review and forthcoming).
